

Guide Drilling Jig

At OZ Roll™ we are constantly looking for ways of improving our product range in all areas of research and development. Some developments are more difficult than others and can take many months or years to perfect. Others such as the Guide Drilling Jig are simple to produce once we have a good idea.

This product has been developed for use by the installer and though it may seem a very simple product it is also very functional. We have noticed, as you no doubt have the amount of guides fitted on the window with damage caused by the drill.

One small slip by an installer or his offsider can reduce a length of guide to scrap in seconds. Chuck marks on the guide and chewed out wool pile are now a thing of the past.

This plastic drill jig is simply inserted into the open face of the guide where it can be easily slid along the length. You then drill the guide through one of the two holes in the jig, maintaining a safe barrier between the drill and guide.

The jig has two holes that are 9mm and 5.5mm, so it can easily be drilled out to the installers preferred sizes. Obviously the plastic jig will not last forever, however the simple design and construction method makes a very inexpensive product.

Roller Shutter Managers can expect there to be no marks on the guide once you have made the Guide Drilling Jig available to your installers. A damaged piece of guide might cost \$20.00 in material but we all know the real cost of changing that guide is far more than \$20.00.
