

Roller Shutter Cleaning Instructions

To ensure your roller shutters are always working their best it is important to give them a clean at least twice a year.



A gentle clean with a mild detergent, clean water and a soft cloth or chamois will remove any built up pollutants and abrasive grime particles between the slats and on the guides.



Spray the closed shutter with a mild detergent and then using a soft brush or cloth wipe shutters in an **UP** and **DOWN** motion so not to misalign the individual slats which could cause operating issues.



Rinse the shutters with clean water and dry with a soft cloth or chamois using the same motion as mentioned above.

To clean between the guides raise the curtain until fully open. Using a soft bristled brush, gently sweep any dirt or particles from inside guide being careful not to dislodge the wool pile. The inside of the guides can also be cleaned with gentle running water from a hose. Allow the guides to completely dry before closing the curtain.
